Rules and Requirements:

- 1. Eligibility: Youth age 8-19 as of January 1, 2021.
- Entries: Entry fees are non-refundable. \$20 per animal. Entries must be postmarked on or before Saturday, August 7, 2021. Late entries will be accepted up until check-in the day of the show for a fee of \$40 per animal. Please Use One Form per Exhibitor.
- 3. All cattle must be free of active communicable disease.
- 4. All animals must be tagged with an official electronic identification (RFID) tag approved by the Michigan Department of Agriculture.
- 5. Bring your own bedding; must clean up all bedding and a manure bunker will be provided.
- 6. Limited barn space available, showing from trailers and generators are encouraged.
- 7. No milking facility on site.
- 8. Concessions will be available.

Educational Contests: *Winners announced the day of the show.

Photography Contest:

Contestants should submit one photo (black and white or color) entry no smaller than 3x5 and no larger than 8x10. All entries must be matted, mounted or framed. The photograph should include cattle in some area of the fore or background. Entries will be judged on quality of photograph, originality of shot/pose, overall audience appeal. Photograph must be the work of the youth participant making entry. Digital photographs are accepted; however, quality of the print will be evaluated. Please include your name and birth date on the back of the entry. Entries must be an original. Photography submission must be checked in the day of the show by 11:00 a.m.

Poster Contest: The topic for the poster contest is: **"Promote your favorite dairy product."** Posters should be original work. Evaluation will be based on (1) neatness, grammar and spelling; (2) clarity of "answer" toquestion; (3) accuracy of information. List all resources used on back of the poster with your name and birth date. Posters must be checked in the day of the show by 11:00 a.m.

Participants can enter the day of the show.

Cow Parts Quiz: Contestants will be tested on their knowledge of the parts of a dairy cow. There will be an educational station where participants will be given a blank dairy cow parts form to complete. Correct spelling of dairy parts will be required. All participants that score a 100% will be given an award/prize. Quizzes must be completed by 12:00 noon the day of the show.
